ABOUT THE POSITION

The instructor will teach rising 9th graders twice a week for four hours per day, helping them develop their creative writing skills. Through fun, interactive, and challenging lessons, students will explore storytelling techniques, sharpen their writing, and push their creative limits. The ideal candidate will create a supportive yet fast-paced environment where students can express their ideas and build confidence in their writing.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Design and deliver engaging, interactive, and intensive lesson plans for a 2-week creative writing course focused on rising 9th graders, covering key concepts like character development, plot structure, and dialogue.
- Provide thoughtful and constructive feedback on student writing throughout the course, helping them improve their skills and develop their own unique writing style.
